LITURGY OF GATHERING

Leader: Reading of <u>Psalm 67</u>. This is the word of the Lord. **ALL: Thanks be to God.**

Trinity is fostering a haven of belonging where wanderers and wonderers gather to discover and embody the love of Jesus in the world.

COMMUNITY CONFESSION

Leader: God created us for goodness, and we make foolish choices. God, who walked this earth, knows our temptations. God, whose hope is for wholeness, waits to forgive us. Let us come to our God, as we confess our lives together, saying,

ALL: God of promises, you offer us guidance, yet we grasp the hand of the world on our journey. You would nurture us with love and grace, and we feast on the empty calories of success and seduction. You call us to be your faithful people, and we are eager to follow the politicians, the promoters, the petty. Forgive us, Covenant God.

Leader: Lord, you have not forgotten your promises, nor will you break them. Rather, you come to us so we will know your love. You walk with us, so we will find the way. You redeem us, so we will trust your words which were fulfilled in Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. *Silent Reflection*

Leader: In every time, in every place, in every life, God shows compassion and mercy. Thus, we know God has heard our prayers and has filled us with grace and hope.

ALL: In this time, in this place, in our lives, our grace and hope are sustained by this abiding love. Thanks be to God, we are forgiven. Amen.

SHARED EXPERIENCE

On The Way - Broad Ripple Neighborhood Walk

Taking a walk through the neighborhood, paying attention to the coexistence of beauty and the not-so-beautiful, let's consider the following:

- The psalmist said "Commit your cause to the Lord; let him deliver—let him rescue the one in whom he delights!" (Psalm 22.8). What weighs on your heart today? Commit these things to the Lord.
- What might God be speaking to us about holding tension, about non-dualistic thinking?
- Today, how does paying attention re-pattern our weeks, our ability to be attuned to where God is moving us?
- What does it look like for us to intentionally walk our own neighborhoods, engage in relationships, paying attention to the coexistence of beauty and the not-so-beautiful?

We'll come back together to marvel in our findings, whether we've collected things on our journey, have a spoken word to share, a prayer to offer, or simply give thanks to God for complete presence with us.

Kids/Family Peace Walk Idea:

While our church family participates in a prayer walk, our kids will be invited to interact in a more expressive way. Before leaving 6151 Central Ave, families will be given sidewalk chalk. As we pause for reflection on our walk, kids will have the opportunity to create something to share with the neighborhood. These will not be elaborate illustrations, but simple offerings to our neighbors. For example, short phrases like, "You belong," "You are loved," "Take a deep breath," "We're glad you're our neighbor," or drawings of hearts, flowers, and smileys would all be blessings to our neighbors.
