## LITURGY OF GATHERING

Leader: Reading of [Psalm 139:1-12, 23-24](#). This is the word of the Lord.

**Have faith that you are with us.**

**This we pray in Jesus' name.**

Leader: Hear the Good News: we are forgiven! We are set free to go out into the world and be the loving, gracious, hopeful people of God!

**ALL: Alleluia! Amen.**
